## **Location**

Located in the lobby of the ground floor of the Library Building, the Campus Safety Department provides service to the campus, incident and alarm response, as well as walk-in and telephone requests. The telephone number for emergency calls is x 3948 while on campus and 717-541-3948 from an off-campus phone line. The department utilizes a foot and vehicular patrol to ensure highly visible coverage of the campus.

## **Safety is a shared responsibility**

To continue to maintain a safe environment, we need the assistance of the entire Widener community. I encourage all of you to report anything that you may consider suspicious. ## **Physical security of your car and personal property**

I ask that you drive slowly through our lots as there is always pedestrian traffic throughout our campus. Please do not remove cones that our Officer's use to designate reserved or special events parking.
