CX Computer Lab:

Several accessible computers are located throughout the Library in addition to the computer lab located on the second floor. Students should not save anything to the hard drives of the law school computers, as any files saved will be erased immediately upon rebooting the PC. CX encourages students to save files to a USB drive or cloud storage such as, Google Drive or Microsoft OneDrive.
