

Timed Exams

You will complete your final exams by logging into [Canvas](#) using your Widener email and password (see specific submission instructions at the end of this document).

1. The Registrar's Office will email each exam access code on the evening before the scheduled exam date at 8:00pm EST.
2. 24-hour window exams will be released on Canvas at 5:00am EST on the scheduled exam date. You will have until 4:59am the following morning to complete. Exams that begin at a specific time will be released promptly at the time scheduled.
3. Once you use the access code to open the exam, exam timing begins. **You will be responsible for monitoring the timing of your exam to ensure that you do not exceed the time limit.** The Registrar's Office will monitor exam times after submissions are completed.

24-hour Window Example

- *Property I P Dernbach 12/7*
- *Access code to open exam is distributed via email from the Registrar's Office at 8pm on December 6.*
- *Exam appears on Canvas at 5:00am on December 7.*
- *You decide to use the password to open the exam at 10:00am on December 7.*
- *You will have until 1:00pm on December 7 to complete and submit the exam (3 hours allotted)*
- *The exam must be completed by 4:59am on December 8.*
- *You are responsible for monitoring the timing of your exam to ensure that you do not exceed the time limit.*

Specific Timed Exam Example

- *Contracts P – Meadows 12/1*
- *Access code to open exam is distributed via email from the Registrar's Office at 8pm on Nov. 30.*
- *Exam appears on Canvas at 9:00am on December 1.*
- *You will have until 11:30am on December 1 to complete the exam (2.5 hours allotted)*
- *You are responsible for monitoring the timing of your exam to ensure that you do not exceed the time limit.*

Take-Home Exams

Unless otherwise instructed by your professor, take-home exams will be available for download on Canvas. Each exam will be opened with an access code.

1. The Registrar's Office will email each access code on the evening before the scheduled distribution date at 8:00pm EST.
2. The exam will be released on Canvas at 5:00am EST on the scheduled distribution date.
3. Once you complete your exam, you must upload it to the Canvas page. This must be done by the due date and time provided by your professor.

Example

- *Family Law, Haynes-Pinsker 12/5*
- *Access Code to open exam is distributed via email from the Registrar's Office at 8pm on Dec. 4.*
- *Exam appears on Canvas at 5:00am on December 5.*
- *You use the access code to open the exam.*
- *You will have until 4:59am on December 6 to complete and submit the exam*


Mock Exam Written Directions






Input the access code that is “access” which enables you to begin your quiz:
